The online world can be accessed via a smartphone, tablet, laptop and games consoles. Whenever your children are in possession of one these, be aware that their safety could be at risk if not used sensibly.

**Always ask yourself:**

Who are they talking to?

What are they looking at?

How are they behaving/being treated?

**Ways to manage risks:**

Contact your broadband provider for basic safety controls.

Activate built in safety options/accounts on all devices around your home for added security.

Invest in 3<sup>rd</sup> party software such as Norton for more detailed monitoring.

Don't give your child master account details as it will allow them to bypass all restrictions.

Talk to your child to help you understand what he/she does online.
