

Phonics and Literacy

Children will continue their learning through Read Write Inc. They will continue to increase their exposure to vocabulary through Talk Through Stories and keep building the fluency of their own reading. Our first story will be Dogger.

At Home

Children will have a reading book and library book to read each week. Please read with your child every day and fill in the reading record.

Computing

This begins with learning more about Purple Mash and developing skills to write simple algorithms.

Geography

Children will be exploring temperature and climate as they explore the differences across the world and decide if they would prefer to live in a hot or cold climate.

In DT, they will be looking at what healthy eating is as well as exploring and healthy foods. This will include learning to prepare foods and create
