We greatly value parental involvement and look forward to working in partnership with you. Attendance

Regular attendance is essential because it supports children's learning, progress and sense of belonging. Even short absences can result in missed learning opportunities.

If your child has only a minor ailment, such as a slight cold, and is otherwise well enough to attend, please send them to school. We will care for them and contact you if they become unwell during the day. Please continue to follow the school's illness and absence guidance.

Uniform

The children look very smart in their school uniforms, and we appreciate your support in maintaining these high standards.

Please remember that the school uniform consists of grey trousers or a grey skirt, a white shirt, a red school jumper or cardigan, and sensible black shoes. Headscarves should be plain and black, white or red.

As the weather becomes cooler, please provide your child with a suitable warm, waterproof coat for breaktimes and lunchtimes. Children should also bring a named water bottle to school each day, particularly on PE days.

Please ensure that all clothing, footwear and belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

PE

PE days vary between the Year 2 classes. On their designated PE day, children should come to school wearing their PE kit.

The PE kit consists of:

- A plain white T-shirt
- Plain black shorts or jogging bottoms
- A black hoodie or jumper for outdoor PE
- Trainers

Trainers should be worn only on PE days and not with the usual school uniform. For health and safety reasons, earrings and watches must be removed for PE lessons, and long hair must be tied back.

Supporting Your Child at Home

Your support at home plays an important part in helping your child to reach their full potential. Reading is central to everything we do in school, so reading regularly at home is invaluable.

Depending on their stage of reading development, children will receive either two phonics books or one Accelerated Reader book. They will also receive a library book. Children are expected to read at home every day, with a particular focus on developing confidence, accuracy and fluency.

Children will also receive new spellings each week. Spelling tests will take place on Mondays, with the new spellings provided later in the week. Please encourage your child to practise these words regularly at home.

Communication

We will continue to use ClassDojo to share important messages, dates and photographs of the children's learning. Please log in as soon as possible and let us know if you experience any difficulties accessing it.

We look forward to working with you throughout the year. Thank you for your continued support with your child's learning and development.
